This change creates confusion in my mind, confusion in my sleep, actually confusion in my life for weeks! Now I'm up at 2:00 a.m., I'm in the bed at 4:00 p.m. I'm eating lunch at 9:00 a.m., dinner at 3:00 p.m., and so on.

But when God makes a change... wow! Allow me to make a couple of points... 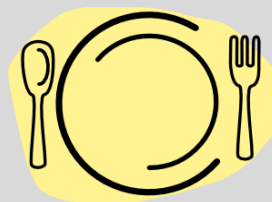
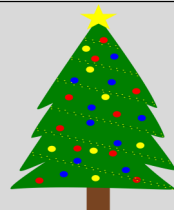
