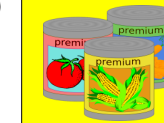


Mission Vision Statement:

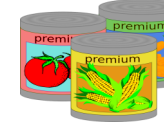

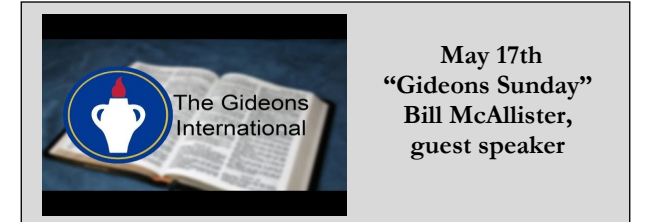

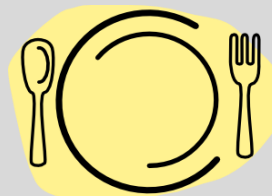
